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1952 Aston Martin DB3 | Previously Sold | FISKENS

The DB3 was introduced in 1951 with a 133 hp (99 kW) 2.6 L Lagonda straight-6 engine from the DB2 Vantage. The car was unsuccessful, so a larger 2.9 L engine, producing 163 hp (122 kW), was introduced in June 1952. The car was placed 2nd, 3rd, and 4th at Silverstone May 1952 (in 2.6 L form) that year behind a Jaguar C-Type.

(1953 - 1956) In the Winter of 1952-3, the decision was made to develop a replacement for the relatively heavy and underpowered DB3.The 'Willie' Watson designed DB3S brought more power from the 2.9 litre straight six engine (initially 182bhp in the works cars, but eventually upto 240bhp) with less weight (down by 75Kg).
