

## 2012 2013 Income Eligibility Guidelines

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### **Income Eligibility Guidelines 2012-13**

These guidelines are used by schools, institutions, and facilities participating in the National School Lunch Program (and USDA Foods in Schools), School Breakfast Program, Special Milk Program for Children, Child and Adult Care Food Program and Summer Food Service Program.

### **Federal Register :: Special Supplemental Nutrition Program ...**

for FYs 2011–2013 affected income eligibility for 2009–2011. Applicants were eligible for reimbursement payments only if their total income was \$70,000 or less (the original income limit was \$80,000), and they met all the other program requirements. Eligible applicants whose income was over \$70,000 but was PTR Income Limits History (1/19)

### **Colorado Judicial Branch - Supreme Court - Chief Justice ...**

Eligibility for children was extended to at least 133% of the federal poverty level (FPL) in every state (most states cover children to higher income levels), and states were given the option to extend eligibility to adults with income at or below 133% of the FPL.

**Colorado Indigent Care Program (CICP) | Colorado ...**

For the Low Income Housing Tax Credit program, the Revenue Ruling  
89-24 states that "...40 percent of the applicable units must be  
occupied by individuals or families having incomes equal to 120  
percent or less of the income limit for a very low-income family of  
the same size."

**Income Eligibility Guidelines - squaremeals**

### **Income Limits | HUD USER**

Colorado expanded its Medicaid program to cover low-income adults starting in 2014, and total Medicaid/CHIP enrollment in the state has grown by 73 percent in the ensuing four years. The state rebranded their Medicaid program as Health First Colorado in 2016, and expanded access to coverage for lawfully-present pregnant women and children.

certain eligibility requirements determined by statute. Eligibility for most Medicaid populations is expressed as a percentage of the federal poverty level (FPL) guidelines. Some populations may also qualify based on other criteria, such as eligibility for federal Supplemental Security Income (SSI) and level of disability.

### **STATE OF COLORADO**

If your income is below 135% of the FPL (\$15,079.50 if you are single or \$20,425.50 for married couples), you could qualify for the full Low Income Subsidy (resource limits also apply - see charts below).

### **Colorado and the ACA's Medicaid expansion: eligibility ...**

Effective January 1, 2013, the Medicaid income threshold for children ages 6 through 18 will be increased from 100% to 133% FPL. Children already enrolled in CHP+ and whose families have income between 100% to 133% FPL will be moved to Medicaid at Renewal, Redetermination or when eligibility is re-run due to a change in circumstance.

### **A17 Income Documentation WIC Income Eligibility ...**

Income Eligibility Guidelines. July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017. Eligibility determination is based on household size and income.

**Colorado**

Eligibility is based on total income and size (i.e., number of household members) of a participant's household. Participants from households whose incomes are at or below the levels shown in the appropriate table, are eligible for free milk. Note: Be sure you use the correct income eligibility guidelines based on the time period.

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
