Linking Verbs, Helping Verbs, and Action Verbs

Linking verbs "link" their subjects to a classification, state of being, or quality. In the sentences above, happy, feverish, doctor, and good are called complements of the linking verbs. Table 1 lists some common linking verbs. Some of these verbs can be both linking and action verbs. Clement felt hot. (linking verb)

Linking verbs are not like action verbs simply because they do not denote an action but instead they indicate a state. What a linking verb will do is it will connect the subject (a noun or a pronoun) with another word or words in the sentence that identify or describe that subject (noun or pronoun).

Action Verbs And Linking Verbs

A linking verb is a verb that describes the subject. Linking verbs connect the subject to a predicate noun or a predicate adjective. Linking verbs do not describe any direct physical or mental action of the subject or any action controlled by the subject. Unlike action verbs, there is only a very short list of words that are true linking verbs.

The verbs appear, become, feel, get, grow, look, remain, seem, smell, sound, stay, taste, and turn can act either as action verbs or linking verbs. In order to tell the difference, you have to pay attention to how each type of verb is used in a sentence—linking verbs are used for descriptions, whereas action verbs tell you what someone (or something) is doing.
