According to the "National Audubon Society Field Guide to Trees," the sweet crab apple may have leaves as long as 4 inches while the Southern crab apple rarely has a leaf 3 inches long. This tree has leaves of a much smaller width, with most between a half-inch and three-quarters of an inch wide.

Examine the leaf's color. All apple tree leaves are bright to dark green on the upper surface, and a duller silver-grayish green on the lower surface. Some apple tree leaves, like those of the sweet crab apple tree, are a yellow-green, while those of a prairie crab apple tree are a shiny green with a subtler hue of green underneath.

Pests that attack the trees include the Japanese beetle, borers, mites and aphids. Also, mice and rabbits chew on the trees' bark during winter. The trees are also susceptible to powdery mildew, scale, fire blight, rust, apple scab, canker and leaf spot. Fire blight is a serious problem that can destroy affected trees.

#### Common Types Of Apple - How To Identify Apple Tree Varieties

Apple trees have bark that is gray and scaly. During the growing season, look for apple tree leaves—coarse and oval—and blossoms, which are pink or white, blooming in spring, made up of 5 petals, and up to three-quarters of an inch across. Many apple trees will also have "spurs," or thorn-like growths, along the branches.
