If an applicant is granted reciprocity, the CSLB may waive the trade portion of the exam, but retains the right to require the exam. The applicant will still be required to take the business law portion of CSLB's exam. Arizona State Board of Technical Registration

No. In order to qualify for registration as a Structural Engineer in the state of Arizona, an applicant must first pass the NCEES 16-hour Structural Engineering examination or have a current registration in Arizona as an Engineer AND meet the requirements of A.R.S.§32.126(B)(1).

Licensing FAQs - Texas Board of Professional Engineers

Please note that the Texas Board of Professional Engineers does not currently have reciprocity with any other U.S. state. Licensees in Texas that wish to be licensed in another state must apply to each state board according to that state's application process.

PE Reciprocity from Canadian PEng to Nevada , Arizona PE ...

What you'll need. Completed Engineer Law Review Exam; Verification of your professional engineering experience. Choose an option: Go to NCEES (ncees.org) and follow the instructions for requesting a license/exam verification.; Complete the applicant portion of the Professional Engineering Experience and Verification form and send it to each experience verifier.

How to get your license: Engineer by comity

The Texas Board of Professional Engineers has been approved by the VA under the GI Bill for reimbursement of examination fees for the FE and PE exams. This approval allows veterans and other eligible persons to receive reimbursement for the cost of license examinations/tests from the VA.

Reciprocity/Comity in Different States - Engineer Boards

Arizona currently requires Structural Engineering applicants to complete the 16-hour NCEES SE Exam and have 3 or 4 years of qualified experience after completing an approved Master's or Bachelor's degree program, respectively, in order to receive professional registration. There are also provisions for licensure through comity with other states.

An applicant may qualify for licensure by reciprocity who: is licensed to practice Professional Engineering in another state or territory of the U.S., and a) provides adequate evidence that, at the time the applicant was licensed in the other state, the applicant met qualifications that were ...

Registered Professional Search | Arizona State Board of ...

An engineer is eligible for reciprocity if they hold a license or registration from a state or territory of the U.S. the requirements and qualifications for which are "reasonably equivalent" to the Professional Engineer's Registration Act. However, comity licensure provisions vary significantly from jurisdiction to jurisdiction. For example, some but not all U.S. jurisdictions require that candidates graduate from an accredited program, and some jurisdictions may waive examination requirements if ...

Arizona Professional Engineer Reciprocity

The Arizona Board of Technical Registration is a self-sustaining regulatory board consisting of nine members, appointed by the Governor, who represent the professional fields regulated by the Board.

In other words, they would receive a "seal of approval" from the state of Arizona once they establish residency in the state, without having to take an Arizona licensing exam or logging the prescribed hours of training. The bill does allow the state to decline this right of reciprocity for a disqualifying criminal history.
