Bacacay is the name of a street in one of the Buenos Aires suburbs Gombrowicz inhabited in 1939, early in his time in Argentina. In Polish, Witold Gombrowicz transformed the original

spelling of the street name from “ Bacacay ” (the Indian name of a battle) to “ Bakaka ĩ ” in order to aid its proper pronunciation in that language
