FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY 101 – A BEGINNER'S GUIDE. That same lens will give an 8 x 12 ft. field of view at a distance of 20 feet. So when you double the distance, the same light is covering an area four times larger (96 square feet vs. 24 square feet)! So you need four times as much light to get the same illumination.
