Book - APA Reference List General Tips. Capitalization: Book title and chapter title are in sentence case - Only the first word and proper nouns in the title are capitalized. Always capitalize the first word, the first word after a colon or a dash. State/Country: Include two-letter state or province abbreviation (if U.S.A or Canada) or name of country (if not U.S.A. or Canada).

APA in-text citation style uses the author's last name and the year of publication, for example: (Field, 2005). For direct quotations, include the page number as well, for example: (Field, 2005, p. 14). For sources such as websites and e-books that have no page numbers, use a paragraph
