The number is stamped onto a raised pad. The frame number is located for BSA's 1969 and earlier on the left side of the frame, on the front engine mounting lug. BSA's 1971 and later, either side of the frame on the steering head to frame gusset, note that these don't always have the model stamped.

The B25 was the fastest British production 250, although was outperformed by contemporary Japanese machines such as the Suzuki T20 Super Six.

Some Bantam's frame numbers are on the engine mounting plate. 1965-1968: The Frame numbers are usually located on the front engine mounting lug. 1968 on: Frame Number is on front engine mounting lug. The engine and frame numbers are the same from 1968 on. 1971 on: The Frame Number in the "oil in frame" models is located on the steering head stem.

BSA Motorcycle Engine & Frame Serial Numbers

This was also listed for sale on eBay. Engine numbers read "A655A". Looking through all literature, BSA never produced a model under a prefix "A65 5A". Now there was the BSA Hornet model with the prefix "A65 HA" but this is clearly much different. Font, numbers and sequence are all incorrect. This engine numbers raise a red flag.

BSA Engine Parts - Classic British Spares

All B44 engine production for the 1966 season (GP and E) shares one numbering sequence from B44 101 upward, production beginning in 9/65. Engines are stamped/numbered at or during engine assembly and are built to either GP or Enduro specification. B44E engines have the "E" added by completion to differentiate them.
