Solving bit-vectors. Z3 mostly uses a bit-blasting approach to deciding bit-vectors. By bit-blasting we refer to a reduction of bit-vector constraints to propositional logic by treating each bit in a bit-vector as a propositional variable. Let us illustrate how bit-vector addition is compiled to a set of clauses.

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From the instantaneous position  $r = r(t)$ , instantaneous meaning at an instant value of time  $t$ , the instantaneous velocity  $v = v(t)$  and acceleration  $a = a(t)$  have the general, coordinate-independent definitions;  $v = \dot{r}$ ,  $a = \dot{v}$ .
