Caught up in an economic spiral, the planters in the South bought more slaves and land to grow more cotton, so they bought more slaves and land. Northern shippers reaped a large part of the profits from the cotton trade; they would load bales of cotton at southern ports, transport them to England, sell their cargo for a profit, and then use the money to buy needed manufactured goods for sale in the United States.
