In either case, the crime is laid out by M.G.L. c. 90, s. 24(2)(a). M.G.L. c. 90, s. 24(2)(a) provides that any individual who operates a motor vehicle recklessly, or operates such a vehicle negligently so that the lives or safety of the public might be endangered shall be held in violation of this law.
