In sum, the Civil War exacted a huge price, primarily in terms of lives lost and ruined in the Confederate Army and in the privations of those left at home. However, the conflict had two vitally positive results for Texas: It freed the state's more than 200,000 enslaved people, and it destroyed the curse of the 'Peculiar Institution' for the entire society of the Lone Star State.
