This is done to prevent any damage to your engine, but also to force you to fix the problem without a delay. Usual causes are faulty EGR valve, swirl flap motor, turbocharger actuator or boost leaks. Make sure you have traced down the actual cause of the problem before changing anything.

Common diesel fuel problems part one - BP

Diesel is much more viscose, greasy and cruder than gasoline. Thus, it is easy to spill it and takes much longer to evaporate. This gives way to dirt and dust settling in, making it harmful for the engine. Moreover, if diesel sticks to the hands and clothes, it is very difficult to remove.

By far and large, the most common problem was the reoccurring failure of one of the systems two NOx sensors. Additional problems included DEF level sensors, DEF pumps, and DEF tank heaters (which often allowed DEF to freeze in extremely cold environments).

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
