Aging blood on MRI is dependent on the varying MRI signal characteristics of hemorrhagic collections with time and can be very useful in correlating the imaging findings with the clinical picture.However, as it can be complicated to recall the MRI features of aging blood through the five stages of hematoma evolution several mnemonics have been devised:

Because the MRI contains strong magnets, metal objects are not allowed into the room with the MRI scanner: Pens, pocket knives, and eyeglasses may fly across the room. Items such as jewelry, watches, credit cards, and hearing aids can be damaged. Pins, hairpins, metal zippers, and similar metallic items can distort the images.

MRI is superior to CT for the diagnosis of discitis and osteomyelitis, particularly early in the course of disease, and should be performed if discitis or osteomyelitis is suspected. Infection of the spinal facet (zygapophyseal) joints is an uncommon cause of neck pain.
