Defination Of Rectifying Journal

If the error is immediately identified it may be fixed by striking out the wrong entry and replacing it with a correct one. However, if the error is identified at a later stage, the correction should be made by passing a suitable journal entry, such entries used to fix an accounting error are called rectification entries.

The rectifying inspection plan is a useful tool in statistical quality control (SOC) to assure the average product quality between several stages of a production line. Those are the errors detected after preparation of trial balance. The errors detected after the completion of accounting year may be one-sided and two-sided errors. Rectification of the errors seen after preparation of trial balance can be made by preparing rectifying journal entries in the subsequent year only.

As these errors do not cause difference in trial balance, the suspense account is not used in the rectifying journal entries.
