A scale is a series of notes in alphabetical order. Music Scales are divided into 2 kinds: 1. Diatonic Scales - consist of tones and semi-tones. It is a seven note 'octave-repeating' scale consisting of 5 whole-steps (tones) and 2 half-steps (semitones) e.g., The 'C Major' diatonic scale would read as follows:

How to Form Diatonic Scales - Major and Minor Scales on ...

The diatonic minor scale is built by starting on the 6th degree of the major scale, and still using the same notes. By changing the relative position of the scale degrees, we also change where the half-steps are. In the case of the natural minor, we get half-steps between the 2nd & 3rd and 5th & 6th degrees. The same interval structure applies to all minor scales:

The Diatonic Scales - Tonality

This gives an array of chords that encompass both major, minor and diminished. This is how the range of chords would emerge from the ascending scale with C as a starting note: C major, D minor, E minor, F major, G major, A minor, B diminished. Each of these chords can be successfully used to support a diatonic melody.

Diatonic scales explained

It is a very helpful booklet with all the diatonic major and minor scales. The minor scales ascend in melodic minor, and then descend in natural minor. The rule in general music theory is that when you use mel minor, you always descend in natural minor. It was created that way in order to function with certain chord progressions.

The diatonic scale has six major or minor triads, while all of the remaining prime scales (the harmonic minor, the harmonic major, the melodic and the double harmonic) have just four major or minor triads. The diatonic scale is the only seven note scale that has just one tritone (augmented fourth/diminished fifth).
