WM ' s speech disorder can therefore be categorised as a lower motor neurone (LMN) dysarthria, which manifests predominantly as a phonatory disorder. The speech disorder should be considered dysarthria as it results from damage to at least one of the cranial nerves leading to deficits in at least one component of the speech production mechanism.
