In addition to the two kinds of irony stated in the earlier response, one very obvious literary element is that of allegory. Miller wrote the play intentionally to comment upon the McCarthy hearings, which were referred to as a "witch hunt" at the time.

The setting of The Crucible is Salem; Allusion - An expression designed to call something to mind without mentioning it explicitly; an indirect or passing reference. John Proctor's mention of Pontius Pilate.
