Let's go over some basic terminology first with regards to the layout of Emacs: Although in standard terminology the running instance of Emacs would be called a window, in Emacs terminology it is called a frame.

Emacs/PSGML Quick Reference
The search is done incrementally as you enter characters in the string. So, for example, suppose I wanted to search for the word "regions". I would type in "r" with no carriage return and Emacs will immediately move the cursor in the main buffer to the next r in the buffer. Now, when I type an "e", Emacs will move to the next location of "re".
