### OSHA Worker Rights and Protections | Occupational Safety ...

Conduct a thorough hazard assessment external icon of the workplace to identify potential workplace hazards that could increase risks for COVID-19 transmission. Identify work and common areas where employees could have close contact (within 6 feet) with others — for example, meeting rooms, break rooms, the cafeteria, locker rooms, check-in areas, waiting areas, and routes of entry and exit.
