This exam, which you may also hear referred to as the Fundamentals of Engineering exam (FE Exam), is developed and administered in all states (and a number of locations outside the US) by the National Council of Examiners for Engineering and Surveying (NCEES).

How to get your Engineer-in-Training certificate

The term "Engineer-in-Training" defines a person certified by the State of Texas as one who has met the following requirements: A graduate of an engineering program or related science curriculum approved by the Board.

Certification of Engineer in Training (EIT)

Engineer-in-Training (EIT) certification applicants must have. Three years or more of postsecondary (college-level) engineering education. OR. Three years or more of engineering-related work experience. OR. A combination of postsecondary (college-level) engineering education and engineering-related work experience totaling three years.

Engineer in Training, or EIT, is a professional designation from the National Council of Examiners for Engineering and Surveying (NCEES) used in the United States to designate a person certified by the state as having completed two requirements:

If you want to be certified as an engineer-in-training in Washington, you must submit the certification application. Certificates are issued only to those applicants that designated Washington as their practice state when they registered to take the fundamentals of engineering exam.
