We evaluated esophageal function using bolus transport time (BTT) and contraction wave velocity (CWV) of liquid, semisolid, and solid boluses. Ten healthy subjects underwent MII swallow evaluation with various boluses of sterile water (pH 5), applesauce, three different sized marshmallows, and iced and 130°F water.

Further investigation may include an esophageal motility study, which is a procedure to assess the motor or muscle function of the esophagus. During this procedure, a very thin, flexible tube is passed through the nose into the esophagus.
