Relays can handle higher current loads than the switch can, but relays are also rated for the amount of current they can handle. Internally, if the current is too much, the circuit opens, and the relay will not function. So it ' s important to use a relay rated for the kind of current load your cooling fan(s) requires.

Where Are My Instructions For My Fan Relay?  
To check which way the air goes, just put your hand in front of the fan to make sure the air is blowing through the radiator. The fan will turn in either direction depending on which of the two wires the power is supplied to. There are two methods to wire the relay, one with manual control and one with automated control.
