The colon sometimes gets as big as 3 inches in diameter! Cats that have megacolon can be treated medically in many cases, but they are rarely cured.

Genetic aganglionic megacolon in rats is a congenital condition similar to Hirschsprung's disease (in humans), lethal white foal syndrome (in horses), piebald related megacolon (in mice), and some types of Waardenburg syndrome (in humans). In genetic megacolon the autonomic nerve ganglions of the smooth muscle of the colon are absent.

Higher dosages (up to 1 mg/kg) may be necessary in cats with moderate to severe constipation. No significant adverse effects have been reported in cats treated with cisapride at dosages of 0.1-1 mg/kg, PO, bid-tid). Cats with longstanding obstipation and megacolon are not likely to improve with cisapride therapy.
