Towing Fifth Wheels. A fifth wheel trailer connects to the bed of a pickup truck using what's called a jaw hitch. This puts the pivot point right on top of the rear axle, which some drivers find to be generally more stable than a travel trailer and easier to maneuver, especially when backing into a campsite.
