Reading and Writing Strategies - Riverview First Grade
Optional Quick Write ~ Students write 5-6 Fluency Words on white boards (not necessary for grades 3 and up). Old Story ~ Students reread for 4 minutes a portion of yesterday's book or chapter for fluency and accuracy. Teacher takes a running record on 1 student. Mini-Lesson ~ The mini-lesson is based on teacher observations of students' needs from YESTERDAY'S book. Introduce the skill in ...

First Grade / Guided Reading
If you work with kindergarten, first grade, or second grade children, you may be familiar with or just discovering "guided reading" as a strategy to help your students become good readers. Guided reading is one component of a four-block reading program, developed by Pat Cunningham and Dottie Hall, which consists of self-selected reading, shared reading, writing, and working with words.
