The shadows at Hiroshima are a haunting reminder of the brutality of the bombing that occurred on August 6, 1945. A US B-29 bomber detonated a nuclear weapon on the city of Hiroshima, destroying much of the architecture and killing more than 70,000 people instantly. Miraculously, there were some survivors. The intense heat of the atomic explosion caused what are called nuclear shadows.
