Ford covers this engine problem under warranty (Technical Service Bulletin TSB 07-21-2). However, if your engine fails after the warranty expires, you are responsible for the repairs. Ford issued a repair kit called the Lock-and-Stitch that allows the owner to install an aluminum insert where the spark plug threads should be.

Engine Oil Pan Gasket Leak An oil pan gasket leak can also occur when engine oil accumulates in the exhaust system of a Ford F-150. As with the head gasket leak, the telltale sign is when the smell of burning oil emits from the engine. A pan gasket is far more affordable to replace and is a relatively easy DIY task.

A few common problems were associated with the 3.0L Ford V6. In its early years the engine was known to have leaking head gaskets. The normal heating and cooling of the engine block would cause the gaskets to fail, which would in turn cause coolant to be sucked into the combustion chambers.

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
