Printing freezer paper foundations You can trace the foundations onto freezer paper, or you can print them directly onto the paper if you have an inkjet printer. (I ' ve read it isn ' t a good idea with a laser printer.) I cut a piece of freezer paper to 8 1/2 " x 11, the size of the regular paper I usually feed through the printer.
