The French Defence is a chess opening. 1. e4 e6. White expands in the centre, while Black immediately challenges the pawn on e4.

The French Defence: Volume Three by Emanuel Berg is the concluding volume of a trilogy by the Swedish Grandmaster. The first two books in the series covered 1.e4 e6 2.d4 d5 3.Nc3 Bb4 while this covers everything else White can try against the French.

After 1. e4 Black plays e6 signifying his intent to play the French Defense. The move 1... e6 bolsters support for the coming advance d7-d5, providing Black with a good stake in the center and allowing Black to decline recapturing with the queen after the plausible continuation exd5.

The French Defense requires a lot of sharp, tactical play. It is "like" the Sicilian insofar as it tries to avoid e5 as a response to e4, and take away the initiative from White. But although "tactical," the Sicilian offers more of a positional game than the French.

### Taming Wild Chess Openings - debestezet.nl

The French defense is a solid and hard to beat chess opening, but Black can feel locked in as the game takes on a blocked character at times, especially in the early phase of the opening. Black has to play on the queenside while White usually plays on the kingside. This opening was not popular in the 19th century as e5 was the usual answer to e4.

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
