With front wheel drive vehicles, you normally have two axles with CV joints on the inner and outer part of the shaft. Sometimes inner CV joints have issues and cause vibrations. These can be very hard to track down. The symptoms usually occur driving at speed, say 65 to 70 mph, and sometimes as low as 55 mph (but not often at that speed).

In a front-engined rear-wheel-drive car, power is transmitted from the engine through the clutch and the gearbox to the rear axle by means of a tubular propeller shaft. The rear axle must be able to move up and down on the suspension according to variations of the road surface.
