Sentencing Guidelines in Federal Court in Criminal Cases ...

A judge decides the sentence for a third-degree felony crime in accordance with state codes. Generally, the more serious the offense and the longer the criminal record, the longer the recommended prison sentence. Most judges have the discretion to deviate from sentencing guidelines if there are mitigating or aggravating circumstances.

All crimes punishable by a sentence of one year or more in prison are felonies under Georgia ' s laws. In contrast, misdemeanor sentences are usually served in county or local jails and are less than one year in length. Georgia does not classify murder as first-degree ("cold-blooded" killings) and second- degree (reckless disregard for human life). In Georgia, any killing with malice or a killing without provocation is murder. The severity of the punishment will depend on the seriousness of the surrounding circumstances. Other types of homicides include voluntary manslaughter and involuntary manslaughter.

Serious Violent Felonies – Penalties Serious violent felonies are subject to mandatory minimum sentences in the State of Georgia. If you are convicted of one of the following, you will be sentenced at least the corresponding prison term.

Sentences for felonies in the state of Georgia are subject to strict guidelines; these guidelines maintain uniformity across the state and take into consideration the rights granted to American citizens by the Constitution (i.e., the Eighth Amendment requires that the state of Georgia give reasonable penalties to persons found guilty of a felony).
