No. If a business is collecting information to help it respond to the coronavirus crisis in order to protect the health, safety and welfare of its staff, this will typically be acceptable under 9(2)(b) grounds and can be done with a "do first, ask later" mentality (see above) (or, in rare circumstances, under Article 9(2)(c) ("vital interests").
