The Goal Attainment Scale (GAS) is an individualized outcome measure involving goal selection and goal scaling that is standardized in order to calculated the extent to which a patient ' s goals are met.

The basic elements of GAS are a 5-point scale ranging from +2 to -2 and descriptions of the target behavior and instructional support that correspond with the following conditions: Best Possible Outcome (+2), No Change in Behavior/Performance (0), and Worst Possible Outcome (-2).
