3. Stage 2: Reading • The second stage, reading, is where the students begin reading the material through any type of reading (buddy, shared, guided, etc.). It includes reading strategies/skills, the examination of illustrations, reading from beginning to end, and note taking.

The heart of guided reading is the second stage: when the teacher listens to each child read to praise progress and determine what else needs to be taught. In all levels of reading, the teacher rotates around the circle, listening to each child read.

Guided reading is a technique which is often used to help students become better independent readers. It involves the teacher working with small groups of students with a similar reading level and supporting them in their skills development.

Stages of Reading Development

At this stage, reading is more automatic, with more energy devoted to comprehension than word attack. Readers are approaching independence in comprehending text. These readers are experiencing a greater variety of text and are able to recognize different styles and genres. Independence often varies with the type of text being read.

Guided Reading

In 1983, she developed the "first stage theory" of reading development. It is important to note that reading is a process that changes as the reader becomes more able and proficient. Her stages described what students typically had to master before moving to the next stage.

Guided Reading (back to Stage 2) Based on careful observation of students, the teacher selects books that are supportive, predictable, and closely matched to the students' needs, abilities, and interests.

Introduce the book you will be reading to the children. A good book introduction will get children interested in reading the book and help them build or access the background knowledge needed to understand the book. Your introduction will be different depending on the reading stage of the children in the group.

In the beginning stages of reading, the reader is learning concepts of print, using word attack strategies to decode words, and developing their sight word bank In the later stages of reading, the reader is focused on fluency, understanding richer vocabulary, and comprehension of a variety of texts

Guided Reading The Stage Is

The hard work that children do when they are learning to read is different for each stage of reading development. This means that what we focus on and spend more time on in Guided Reading should change depending on the reading stage a child is in. For example, early readers are doing a lot of hard work in decoding.

Guided reading explained Children will be divided into ability groups, according to their reading levels. The teacher will choose a set of books for the group she or he is reading with, that is appropriate to their level. Generally, teachers need to think about two things when carrying out a guided reading session: decoding and comprehension.

By this stage, reading is used to learn new ideas in order to gain new knowledge, to experience new feelings, to learn new attitudes, and to explore issues from one or more perspectives. Reading includes the study of textbooks, reference works, trade books, newspapers, and magazines that contain new ideas and values, unfamiliar vocabulary and syntax.

Guided reading is one component of the shared reading block during which the teacher provides support for small, flexible groups of beginning readers. The teacher helps students learn to use reading strategies, such as context clues, letter and sound knowledge, and syntax or word structure, as they read a text or book that is unfamiliar to them.
