The Knucklehead's big twin engine was the first in which Harley-Davidson used a recirculating oil system, making the engine capable of harder use and increasing its reliability in extreme temperatures (because the oiling system could cool the hottest parts). The knucklehead is a retronym used by enthusiasts to refer to a Harley-Davidson motorcycle engine, so named because of the distinct shape of the rocker boxes. The engine is a two-cylinder, 45 degree, pushrod actuated overhead valve V-twin engine with two valves per cylinder. It was the third basic type of V-Twin engine used by Harley-Davidson, replacing the Flathead-engined VL model in 1936 as HD's top-of-the-line model.

By 1937, all Harley-Davidson flathead engines were equipped with dry-sump oil recirculation systems similar to the one introduced in the "Knucklehead" OHV engine. The revised 74 cubic inches (1,210 cm 3) V and VL models were renamed U and UL, the 80 cu in (1,300 cm 3) VH and VLH to be renamed UH and ULH, and the 45 cu in (740 cm 3) R to be renamed W. [34]
