Apply for Heating and Cooling Assistance (HEAP)

The HEAP income limits are published on the New York Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance website. Households are only eligible if the income falls below the specified limits based on the household size. For example, 2014-2015 guidelines limit a family of three to a monthly gross income of \$3,544.

The HEAP year generally begins in November and closes when the program funding is exhausted, which can be as early as mid-March. Regular HEAP. There are no resource eligibility criteria for Regular HEAP. Regular benefit amounts range from \$20 to \$500. Amounts depend on income, age of household members, energy costs and shelter situation.

You may be eligible for a Cooling Assistance HEAP benefit if: Your household's gross monthly income is at or below the current income guidelines for your household size as posted in the following table, or you receive Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP, formerly known as Food Stamp) benefits, or you receive Temporary Assistance (TA), or you receive Code A Supplemental Security Income (SSI Living Alone), and you and your household members are United States Citizens or qualified ...
