TIFF produces large files, thanks to a common resolution of 300 ppi with no quality loss. TIFF also preserves layers, alpha transparency, and other special features when saved from Photoshop.

Typical printing ppi values range from 150 to 300 ppi, although some high-end magazines may require images which are 1200 ppi. So, for example, if you want to print an image 4 x 6 inches at 300 ppi, then you need a file that has at least 4 x 300 (1200) pixels along its short side and 6 x 300 (1800) pixels on the long side.
