

## How To Answer Inference Questions

To correctly answer the question, first you must read the question carefully. Then, you must find the key word in the sentence, before finding it in the paragraph. Read the sentence that contains the key word, and also read the sentences immediately before and after the key words.

Inference Questions. So, make sure that the answer choice you select is very closely related to what the question is asking. Be on the lookout for answer choices that change the meaning of details within the passage. Usually, you can eliminate at least one answer choice that contradicts (goes against) the passage.

How to answer the 4 mark inference question

These are known as "inference questions" since you read between the lines of a passage and make an inference, a logical deduction, based on what you've read. These questions are easy to identify on the exam. You'll see keywords like "infer," "suggest," and "imply" in the question itself.

1. Skim the questions " not the answer choices " before reading the passage. 2. Questions about main idea might use the words "theme," "generalization," or "purpose." 3. Save questions about the main idea for last. On standardized tests like the SAT, the answers to the rest of the questions can be found in order in the passage. 3.

The key to answering these questions correctly is to remember that they usually ask you to make an inference based on information in the paragraph's statements rather than draw an overall conclusion based on all of them. So you should choose an answer that makes a plausible inference about or connection between one or more of the statements.

TOEFL Reading Preparation: How to Attack These 3 Question ...

Remember, an inference is NOT directly given in the passage. It's important to understand the question type to avoid wrong answers. In inference questions, any answer choice which repeats/ rephrases something from the passage is WRONG. Instead, the inference should be based on one of the lines from the given facts/reading comprehension.

### How to Answer Reading Comprehension Questions

For inference questions, you'll need to use the stated information in the text to draw a conclusion about unstated information. There are a couple of common themes among inference questions. For example, they often deal with a "cause and effect" situation by stating the effect of a change. The question will then ask you to identify the cause of that effect.

How to Identify an Inference Question. One crucial part of your studies is learning how to identify question types. Without knowing what you are asked to do, you can't be successful. Usually the question stem will have a word or phrase that will signal it's an inference question, like "infer," "imply," or "suggests."
