Enclose short quotations in double quotation marks. For quotes of fewer than 4 typed lines or 3 lines of a poem, type the information verbatim from your source text, putting double quotation marks around it. Include punctuation inside the quotation marks only if they are part of the source text.

Move the period from the end of the sentence, and place it after the closing parenthesis. This placement binds the citation to the quote.

Cite a long quotations in a block. As with APA formatting, using the Chicago Manual you need to place quotations longer than 4-5 lines in a free-standing block. Start the quote on a new line, indented 0.5 inches (1.3 cm) from the left margin. Include the page numbers of the quote in parentheses at the end of the quote.

For a citation with one or more authors, include their last names, the year of publication, and page number preceded by a "p." If you're citing something but don't know the author, put the title of the publication and its date in parentheses.

Short quotations. To indicate short quotations (four typed lines or fewer of prose or three lines of verse) in your text, enclose the quotation within double quotation marks. Provide the author and specific page number (in the case of verse, provide line numbers) in the in-text citation, and include a complete reference on the Works Cited page.

The format for this type of citation is, in parentheses: Author's last name, year of publication, page on which the citation is located. Cite the source of your quote within the text of your paper. The American Psychological Association (APA) Style requires listing the author's name and the date the quote appeared in print. Use parentheses immediately following the quote, such as (Webster, 1979).
