How to Cite a Chapter in a Book in APA Format in Text - A ...

To cite a chapter in a book in a reference entry in Harvard style include the following elements. Author(s) of the chapter: Give the last name and initials (e. g. Watson, J.) of up to three authors with the last name preceded by 'and'. For four authors or more include the first name followed by et al., unless your institution requires referencing of all named authors.

To cite a book chapter in MLA, put the author's last name, followed by the page number the quote appears on in parentheses at the end of the quote. Additionally, create an entry in the Works Cited page, starting with the author's last name, followed by a comma and their first name.

How To Cite a Chapter From a Book in APA Format

In-Text Citation. An in-text citation can appear in parentheses after a paraphrase or a direct quote. It includes the author's last name followed by the year of publication and page number, if applicable. For a chapter in a book, only the chapter's author is included; there is not need to mention the editor or book title. For example:

To cite a book chapter in APA with an in-text citation, write the author's name to introduce the quote, such as "According to J. O'Neill..." Then, put the publication year and the page number in parentheses at the end of the sentence.

Use this format if you are using 1 chapter out of a book that has many chapters, and each chapter is written by a different author. If each chapter is written by the same author, just cite the entire book. Parts of the APA Citation Explanation Author's Last name, First initial. Middle initial. Example: Hager, R. J.

In-Text Citations. To begin, immediately following a quotation or a paraphrase, APA citation style requires an in-text citation. Typically, these in-text references include the author's last name, followed by a comma and the year. You do not need to include the title of the chapter for most in-text citations. General Format

Citing a chapter from an edited book. When citing a particular chapter from a book containing texts by various authors (e.g. a collection of essays), begin the citation with the author of the chapter and mention the book's editor(s) later in the reference. A page range identifies the chapter's location in the book:
