What to do with a "Citation Within a Citation" in MLA Style

Citing an Article in a Book Using MLA. 1. Start with the author ' s name. In the bibliography, begin with the essay author ' s last name first, followed by a comma and the first name. For example: " Whistler, George. " . 2. Add the title of the essay next. Place the title in quotation marks.

How to Cite a Reference Within a Reference in APA Format ...

Cite web pages in text as you would any other source, using the author and date if known. If the author is not known, use the title and the date as the in-text citation (for long titles just use the first few words).

APA: Citing Within Your Paper. What is an APA In-Text Citation? An in-text citation is a citation within your writing that shows where you found your information, facts, quotes, and research. All APA in-text citations require the same basic information: Author ' s last name (no first names or initials)

Start the quotation on a new line, indented five spaces from the left margin. Type the entire quotation on the new margin, and indent the first line of any subsequent paragraph within the quotation five spaces from the new margin. Maintain double-spacing throughout. The parenthetical citation should come after the closing punctuation mark.

Indirect "source inside a source" - APA Style, 6th Edition ...

Citing a source within a source is acceptable within academic writing as long as these citations are kept to a minimum. You should use a secondary source only if you are unable to find or retrieve the original source of information. However, if you need to cite a source within a source, follow the guidelines from page 178 in the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association, Sixth Edition.

APA (American Psychological Association) - Citation Guide ...

Kirkey will appear in your Works Cited list – NOT Smith. You will add the words " qtd. in " to your in-text citation. Examples of in-text citations: According to a study by Smith (qtd. in Kirkey) 42% of doctors would refuse to perform legal euthanasia.

There is no need to note that you are quoting a source within the source as part of this reference. When citing quoted material in the body of your text, mention the original source in the sentence and the secondary source in a parenthetical citation at the end of the line.

How to Reference a Citation Within a Citation in APA Style

Harvard Referencing Style. Sometimes an author writes about research that someone else has done, but you are unable to track down the original research document. In this case, only include the source you did consult in your references because you did not read the original document. Use the words 'cited in' in the in-text citation to indicate you...

How do you cite a source that you found in another source?

To cite a source you found in another source, state the original author (direct source) within your sentence and state "qtd. in" followed by the last name and year of the secondary source. For example: According to Smith, students need faculty and staff support to succeed (qtd. in Brown).
