Remove bubbling joint compound and paint using a putty knife to scrape off all the damaged material. Remove peeling joint tape by cutting it free. Trace the tape back to just outside the damaged area and cut straight across it with a drywall knife. Pull the loose tape off and scrape away any loose joint compound.

Use a drywall or keyhole saw to cut out the drywall you want to remove. Be on the lookout for wires and plumbing as you go. Take your time. Measure & Install Replacement Pieces. After removing the damaged drywall, measure the size of the hole so you can cut out a patch from a new sheet of drywall. Place four drywall clips around the hole. Secure each one in place with a drywall screw, making sure to countersink the screw head.

How to Fix Damaged Drywall Paper

Cut the loose edges from the drywall paper with a utility knife. Sand the edges where paper was removed with a fine-grit sanding pad. Wipe the sanding dust with a clean cloth. Stir a can of sealing primer with a paint stick. Place a pan liner into a paint pan and fill the pan with primer.

To feather the edge, increase pressure and angle on the drywall knife as you reach the outer edges of the patch area to minimize, or thin, the joint compound on the drywall. Step 3 Let the patch dry and apply a second coat of compound if needed.

Poke a small hole in the middle of the drywall and slip a string through it. Tie several knots in the string until the knot grows large enough so when pulling from the other side the knot will keep the string from coming back out of the hole.
