The in-text citation is written inside a parenthesis usually with the last name of the author and year of publication, separated by a comma. Example: (Simon, 1945) If the name of the author is included in the text, write only the year inside the parenthesis.

How To Reference A Textbook

Provide the title of the textbook. If you used the entire textbook as a reference, put the full title in italics after the year of publication. To find the correct title, look on the title page, not the cover of the book. Use sentence-style capitalization, only capitalizing the first word of the title.

Make sure to: Add doi (Digital Object Identifier) if it is available after at the end of the citation instead of URL. If you used an e-reader, you should still include the URL that you retrieved the book from, for example, www.amazon.com.

The basic structure of a book reference should list the author's last name, first initials, publication year, book title, location, and publisher. Your reference should appear as follows: Author, I. N. (Year).
