Finish with date and location information for a print journal. After writing the article title, add the year of publication, volume number, issue number, and page numbers for the article cited. If there is no volume or issue information, use the month of publication instead. Follow the format year;volume(issue):pages.

How to Reference Journal Articles in APA Format

In your reference list entry for a journal article or other online source, APA currently recommends writing the full DOI address that gives access to the article. For example: <https://doi.org/10.1037/rev0000126>. The old guidelines were to present DOIs by writing "doi:" followed by the numerical string. For example: doi:10.1037/rev0000126

Harvard - writing reference list

To begin writing in your journal, label your first entry with the date, time and, optionally, location. For instance, you might start with "Monday, January 1, 1.00p.m., Bedroom". Next, if you'd like to, write a salutation. Many journal-writers like to use "Dear Journal" or a similar greeting to start each entry.

Your work should be both referenced in the text and include a reference list or bibliography at the end. The in text reference is an abbreviated version of the full reference in your reference list.

How To Write Journal References

If an article has two authors, follow the basic format for a journal reference. Place a comma after the first initial of the first author followed by an ampersand (&). Then include the last name and first initial of the second author.

APA Referencing Basics: In-Text Citation In-text references must be included following the use of a quote or paraphrase taken from another piece of work. In-text citations are citations within the main body of the text and refer to a direct quote or paraphrase. They correspond to a reference in the main reference list.

Oxford - writing reference list

In general, a reference will include authors' names and initials, the title of the article, name of the journal, volume and issue, date, page numbers and DOI. On ScienceDirect, articles are linked to their original source (if also published on ScienceDirect) or to their Scopus record, so including the DOI can help link to the correct article.

An MLA Works Cited entry for a journal article contains the author(s); article title; journal name; volume and issue; month and year; page range; and a DOI if accessed online. In the in-text citation, include the author's last name and the page number.

Journal articles (scholarly articles) Include (if available): Last name(s) and first name(s) of author(s). Year of publication. Title of article. Journal name Volume(issue): page numbers of article. Permanent link or URL. Example: Lundmark, Linda. 2005.

Journal articles (scholarly article) Include (if available): Family name(s) and first name(s) of author(s). Title of article. Journal name. Volume, issue, year of publication: page numbers of article. Permanent link or URL. Lundmark, Linda. Economic Restructuring into Tourism in the Swedish Mountain Range. Scandinavian Journal of Hospitality and Tourism.

Give an in-text citation (i.e. in brackets or footnotes, depending on the style you are using) at the place where they are included in your writing and a full citation in the

bibliography or reference list for the text you got them from. This includes graphs and tables, as well as illustrations and photographs.

The International Committee of Medical Journal Editors (ICMJE) offers guidance to authors in its publication Recommendations for the Conduct, Reporting, Editing and Publication of Scholarly Work in Medical Journals (ICMJE Recommendations), which was formerly the Uniform Requirements for Manuscripts.

How to write correct references - Sources, citing and ...

To cite an online journal or newspaper article, the page numbers section from the print journal or newspaper reference is swapped with the URL or DOI the article can be accessed from and when it was accessed. So the reference for an online journal article is: Author surname (s), initial (s).

How to cite a journal article in APA Style

The foundation of the reference is the same as for a journal article. Include the description " [Supplemental material]" in square brackets after the article title. If you cite both the main article and the supplemental material, provide only a reference for the article.
