In this way, Kabbalists developed the symbol into a full model of reality, using the tree to depict a map of Creation .

The Kabbalah Tree of Life has been called "an archetype scheme which is the divine model for the Universe and for Man' 2. The Tree of Life of the 10 Sephirot stretches from the Divine nature of the Creator (referred to as Eyn Sof, אֵין סוֹף without end), which is above or beyond the Sefirot, and physical existence, which is below the Sephirot and comes forth from them.

Tree of Life Kabbalah

The Kabbalah Tree of Life seems to confirm this as well: each of the 32 paths of the Kabbalah Tree of Life has a "Mystic" number. It is determined by the sum of the prior path with the current path. The final Mystic number for Path 32 adds up to 528!

Kabbalists believe the tree of life to be a diagrammatic representation of the process by which the universe came into being. On the tree of life, the beginning of the universe is placed in a space above the first sphere (named "Keter" or "crown" in English).
