Basically, manual duplex printing is exactly what it sounds like: if you want to print double sided, you have to manually flip the paper over after printing the first side so you can then send the document through again to print the other side.

Ideally, the speed and duplex settings should be set not auto-negotiated. The fastest for your example would be 1000mbps full duplex. Full duplex means "send / receive" at the same time.

In addition to Ron answer, Auto-MDIX does not negotiate speed and duplex, it auto-configures which pairs in the cable are used for Transmit and Receive. But on some switches auto-mdix is disabled if you manually set speed and duplex, which could lead to some confusion.

Printing on both sides of paper is called duplex printing. Most printers offer the option of automatically printing on both sides of a sheet of paper (automatic duplex printing). Other printers provide instructions so that you can manually reinsert pages to print the second side (manual duplex printing).

If you set speed and duplex at one end of a link, unless you set the other end the same, the link set as auto will default to 10 meg half-duplex. This is the default operation of an auto port. If it cannot agree with the other end on speed and duplex, it will default to its slowest speed/duplex.
