Generalized Anxiety Disorder
The characteristics of GAD as described in the DSM-5 are shown in Table 1-1. The issues assessed on two common screening instruments (i.e., the Generalized Anxiety Disorder 7-Item scale (GAD-7) and the Penn State Worry Questionnaire) are shown beside these criteria for reference. A score greater than 10 on the GAD-7 suggests a diagnosis of GAD.
