The migration can be from older WebSphere Application Server releases and from such application servers as Apache Tomcat Server, Oracle WebLogic Server, JBoss Application Server, and Oracle AS.

If the customer would like to migrate a WebSphere MQ v7.0.4 File Transfer Edition (FTE) agent to IBM MQ v8 Managed File Transfer (MFT) that runs on a new server, I would suggest they do this as a two step process:

Beginning with version 3.4, IBM TRIRIGA Application Platform no longer supports deployment on JBoss Application Server (community edition) for production environments. WebSphere Application Server Community Edition servers

WebSphere Application Server Community Edition (from now on WASCE) is a free-of-charge, certified Java EE 6 application server for building and managing Java applications. It is IBM's supported distribution of Apache Geronimo that uses Tomcat for servlet container and Axis 2 for web services. Other difference from Apache Geronimo is that WASCE comes with DB2 and Informix database drivers ...
